FLO stands for Family Liaison Officer. We provide support to children and families across Kent and are based in schools across the county.

Why?

To help children and families who may be experiencing difficulties. We try to make a real difference to the lives of children and young people at risk of social exclusion, as well as being a friendly face and a source of support for any child, or family within our school community.

Who Do FLOs work with?

An integral part of the FLO role, is linking families with other agencies, both statutory and non-statutory and working in partnership with them.
