Welcome Back

Attendance

The DfE has an attendance target of 95% or

above. This equates to approximately, 10

days absence in a year.

Educational outcomes for children with less

than 95% attendance are statistically poorer

than for those with attendance above 95%.

This is because if a child is not in school (for whatever reason) they will not be learning the things their peers will be.

Last year at Guston, 73 pupils (48% of the school) had attendance below 95%.

Letters will be being sent to relevant families

next week and we will be monitoring

attendance very closely in the coming

months.

We will obviously be working with families to

improve attendance and in cases of

unavoidable illness absences, working with

families to support with missed learning.
