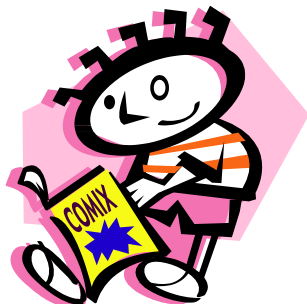


Dear Parents,

English

This term English will be taught mainly through Read Write Inc. The children will be using punctuation including capital letters (A), full stops (.), question marks (?), exclamation marks (!) and inverted commas ("a").

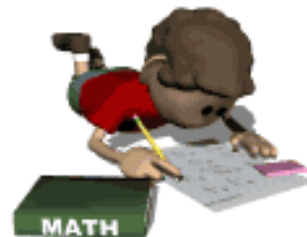
It is also important that the children read everyday at home as well as at school. The children will read a range of fiction and non-fiction books during guided reading.



Mathematics

We will be making graphs and charts; working on place value up to 100, partitioning numbers into tens and units, reviewing our number bonds to ten and twenty; addition and subtraction of 1 and 2 digit numbers; multiplication and division (without remainders) of numbers up to 50 by 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10. Working using standard measure for weight (g & kg), length (cm & m) and capacity (ml & l) and the relationships between them.

$$53 = 50 + 3$$
$$1\text{kg} = 1000\text{g}$$
$$1\text{m} =$$
$$100\text{cm}$$
$$1\text{l} = 1000\text{ml}$$



Science

Our science this term is about animals in their environment. We will be learning about how animals adapt to the place in which they live, what they eat and how they all fit together to form an ecosystem. We will be studying the plants and animals in our local area.



R.E.

Our RE is based upon Hinduism. The children will learn about the origins and important features of Hinduism some of the symbols related to the religion and about stories of the different gods and what they mean.



Topic

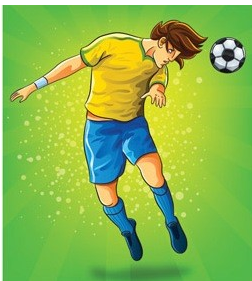
This term we will be studying invaders of Britain focussing on the Normans and the Norman Conquest. We will make a visit to Dover Castle to help with our studies.
