SNAPCHAT

It has been brought to our attention that there is a new mapping facility (Snap Map) on Snapchat which automatically allows users to view friends locations and

their 'stories' and other users stories without having permission. This is because the default position for 'Snap Map Stories' is public. Therefore anyone can see stories that you share and can link it to a specific location. This has become a particular issue when parents have shared stories from Sports Day. You

can change your settings to 'Ghost mode' which will mean you will not feature in Snap Map. You will however be able to see other users.

Please be mindful of using this facility, particularly at events linked to the school. Personal information, such as the name of the school a child attends, should be kept private.
