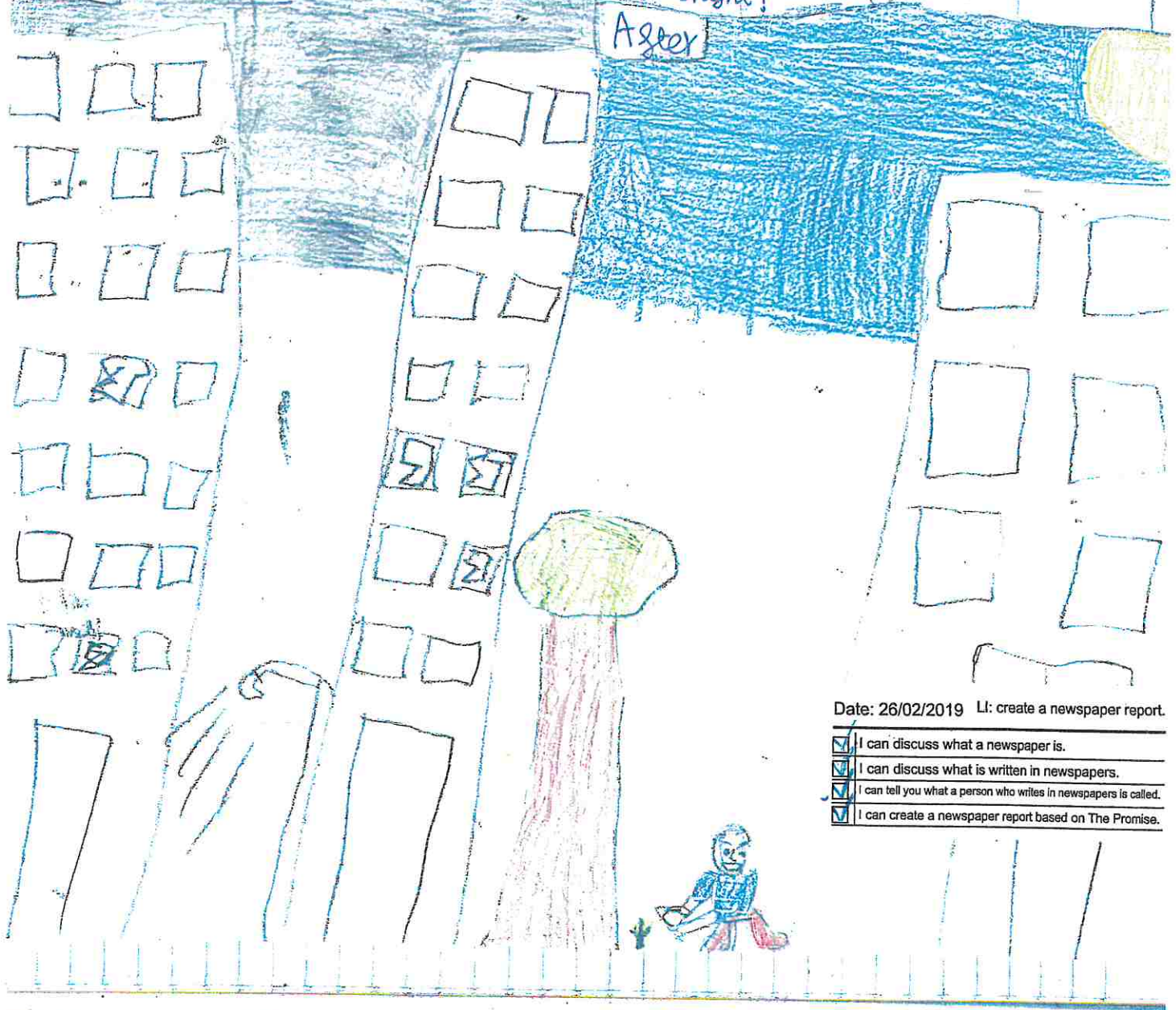
BIG change IN A CITY!! AMAZING
