GO!

This amazing game is about strategy and technique it will also blow your mind. If you want or like strategy games this game is for you! Read on to find more about GO.

Equipment

- 50 black stones
- 50 white stones
- 10x10 'GO' board

Setting up

1. Place the board on a flat surface and that should stop the board from being uneven.
2. Now players should choose black or white counters to play with.
3. The player who is the most inexperienced player will go first.

How to play-
Players take turns placing stones on the board one by one.

Stones must be placed on the corners of the little squares.

The game continues like this till the one of the players stones have finished or if one of the players gives up.

Rules

1. The player with the black stones places one of their stones on the board.

2. Then, the players would keep taking turns to place their counters on the board.

3. If one of the players surround their opponent's stone it will be now captured and officially removed of the board and then you can't place players can't place stones in that area.

4. If there is not enough space on the board the game could stop or end and count up your points.

5. To receive points surround your opponent's stones and players will receive points.

How to win

To win, players must gain the most points by surrounding the opponents stones or by placing the most stones on the board with strategy. At the end of the game count up your points and whoever has the most points win.

Captured counters = 30 points

Counters on the board = 10 points
(Per counter)
