Happy New Year

It has been so lovely to have the majority of children back in this term. We are missing a few due to isolation and we look forward to having them back with us very soon.

Thank you for your patience in reading my COVID Update letters! The Government and DfE do like to keep us all on our toes with changing guidance and approaches. I hope the updates are useful and clear. If you have any questions though, please do not hesitate to contact me.

The take home points for me are:

From 11th January: If you have symptoms, you need to have an PCR Test. However, if you are asymptomatic and take an LFD (Lateral Flow Device) Test as a precaution or part of routine testing and test positive, you do not need a PCR to confirm. The LFD result needs to be registered.

Self isolation can be completed on day 7 if you are fully vaccinated or under the age of 18 and 6 months and test negative on an LFD on Days 6 and 7, 24 hours apart.

Close contacts of positive cases no longer need to have PCR, instead they are encouraged to complete daily LFD's for 7 days.

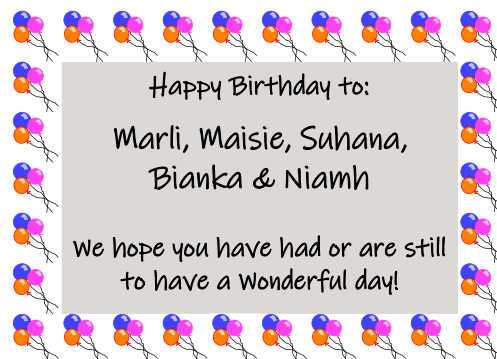
