As I understand it, Support bubbles are made between two households, one of which must only have one adult living there. Informal childcare arrangements can be maintained if it is one other household and is used only to necessitate attending work.

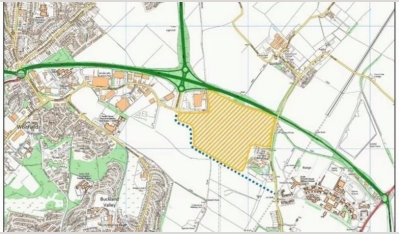
CHILDREN IN NEED - 13th November
