It's a tough, climb, but the views out over Murlough Bay and the small town of Newcastle are worth the effort. The Tollymore Forest Park is located at Bryansford, near the town of Newcastle in the Mourne and Slieve Croob area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and the foot of the Mourne Mountains.
