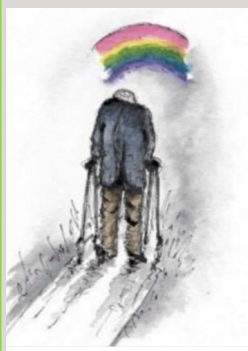

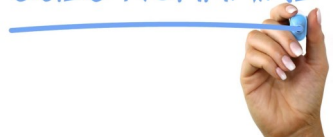
"One little soul like me won't make much difference, I hope that it does but it won't will it."

Julia Donaldson Quiz

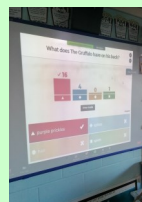


Mr Wells has been busy this week running a Julia Donaldson quiz for all the bubbles in school. It was great to see them all engaged, happy and competitive!
